As the university awaits the final passing of the Anti-Discrimination Bill, may I request that **the student-petitioner** be accorded with the respect due her as a person with equal rights and selfless dedication for herself and family.

LGBT Contract / Agreement Form

- I, (NAME) a student of RSU (Campus/College) has been granted permission to retain or grow my hair long upon my petition in order to gain confidence and to express myself in the gender I am most comfortable with. Given the consideration granted to me, I also commit myself to abide by the following rules in order to ensure the successful completion of my chosen degree program and to remain dignified and respectable at all times without causing offense against others and or gaining undue attention from others. I agree to:
 - **a.** come to class on time and on a regular basis; in times of sickness and emergencies, I shall inform my instructor in writing about my absence
 - **b.** focus on my academic commitments and to refrain from involving or engaging in any activity that might exploit, abuse or destroy my physical body
 - **c.** keep my relationships with peers, classmates, staff, teaching personnel and other members of the community prudent, diplomatic and peaceful at all times
 - **d.** use gender-fair, sensitive and respectful language to everyone without making premature judgments
 - **e.** use appropriate clothing (no short shorts, no ripped jeans, no fitting jeans/ sweat pants, plunging V-neck or hanging shirts or blouses, no high-heeled or stiletto shoes, unnecessary jewelry) during school days except on parties when the occasion or event allows **f.** refrain from wearing outlandish make-up or make overs that are inappropriate or offensive in a school setting
 - g. behave appropriately in and outside the class without malice, dishonesty, pretense, intent to cheat, discriminate or exclude anyone, or attempt to call attention to oneself
 - **h.** keep my hair neat and clean at all times, in its natural (non-dyed) color; and in the interest of safety and hygiene, hair that is long enough must be worn off the face and tied up. **i.** communicate with the GAD Director, Guidance Counselor or the GAD / Guidance Coordinator on a regular basis when in doubt or when in need of other support services or programs. **j.** actively participate in students' development programs/ activities organized by the University without sacrificing class hours and other academic requirements

I understand that my success in this University requires my steadfast commitment and patience; and that my full and decisive cooperation to the rules set by the Gender and Development Office serves as a guide in developing my fullest potential as a person and in completing my college degree.
